



## COVID 19 & Omicron variant Measures of Control

Action taken by	What to do if...	Action needed	Return to nursery when...
H&S manager (Lénaïg Brilla) and Covid-19 measures coordinator (Grace Godard)	<p>A member of staff tests positive to a weekly lateral flow test</p> <p>OR</p> <p>A member of staff is a close contact of someone who tested positive for Covid-19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All members of staff informed and asked to take an additional lateral flow test</li> <li>• Member of staff affected to book and report PCR test results ASAP</li> <li>• Families informed via email</li> </ul>	<p>If PCR test comes back negative</p> <p>or</p> <p>After the 10 days isolation period</p>
Parents	<p>My child has Covid-19 symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HIGH TEMPERATURE – this means they feel hot to touch on chest or back</li> <li>• A LOSS OR CHANGE TO YOUR SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE – this means they've noticed they cannot smell or taste anything.</li> </ul>	<p><b>DO NOT COME TO NURSERY</b></p> <p>Contact the nursery to inform us. Self-isolate the WHOLE household while getting the symptomatic person tested. Get a test. INFORM THE NURSERY OF THE TEST RESULT</p>	<p>The test comes back negative and if the fever is gone.</p> <p>Children can return with a cough after a negative test as this can last for some time.</p>

Parents          H&S manager (Lénaïg Brillu) and Covid-19 measures coordinator (Grace Godard)	Child tests positive for Covid- 19	<b>DO NOT COME TO NURSERY</b> Contact the nursery to inform us.  Families informed via email.	10 days after PCR test or first symptoms
Parents	My child tests negative	<b>CONTACT THE NURSERY</b> Discuss when your child can come back to nursery (same day/next day).	The test comes back negative.
Parents	My child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19	FOLLOW USUAL NURSERY ABSENCE POLICY PROCEDURE	For sickness/diarrhoea MUST be clear for 48 hours before returning to nursery.

### OMICRON SPECIFICS

Staff or family of child with symptoms	Suspicion of staff/child/family member having contracted the Omicron Variant  Or Suspicion of being a close contact of a person that has contracted the omicron variant	<b>DO NOT COME TO NURSERY</b> Contact the nursery to inform us.  Book a PCR test  Self isolate and Follow NHS Test and Trace advice	According to NHS test and Trace advice
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
