Action taken by	What to do if	Action needed	Return to nursery when
H&S manager (Lénaïg Brillu) and Covid-19 measures coordinator (Grace Godard)	A member of staff tests positive to a weekly lateral flow test OR A member of staff is a close contact of someone who tested positive for Covid-19	 All members of staff informed and asked to take an additional lateral flow test Member of staff affected to book and report PCR test results ASAP Families informed via email 	or After the 10 days isolation period
Parents	My child has Covid-19 symptoms: · HIGH TEMPERATURE – this means they feel hot to touch on chest or back · A LOSS OR CHANGE TO YOUR SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE – this means they've noticed they cannot smell or taste anything.	DO NOT COME TO NURSERY Contact the nursery to inform us. Self-isolate the WHOLE household while getting the symptomatic person tested. Get a test. INFORM THE NURSERY OF THE TEST RESULT	The test comes back negative and if the fever is gone. Children can return with a cough after a negative test as this can last for some time.

Parents	Child tests positive for Covid- 19	DO NOT COME TO NURSERY Contact the nursery to inform us. Families informed via email.	10 days after PCR test or first symptoms

Parents	My child tests negative	CONTACT THE NURSERY Discuss when your child can come back to nursery (same day/next day).	The test comes back negative.
Parents	My child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19	FOLLOW USUAL NURSERY ABSENCE POLICY PROCEDURE	For sickness/diarrhoea MUST be clear for 48 hours before returning to nursery.
